

KNOW THE RULES



HITS

If a ball hits you and is not caught while still in the air, you are out and must wait in the out line in the order you got out.



CATCHES

Catching a ball gets the thrower out and the player at the beginning of your out line rejoins the game.



BLOCKING

Once a ball is blocked with another ball, it becomes a dead ball. However, if the ball you use to block is knocked out of your hand from the ball that has been thrown – that is considered a failed block and the player is out.



THE REF IS ALWAYS RIGHT

If a ref calls you out, you are out! No exceptions. Arguing will only earn you a yellow or red card.



TEAM WINS

Last team standing or team with more active players after 7 minutes wins the game.

DON'T BE A JERK

You can be kicked out of a game if your behavior is out of hand. We're all here to have fun, not fight.



HEAD SHOTS

If a ball hits your head first straight from a throw, you are safe. However, the thrower is out. Head shots from deflections count as hits.



3-POINT RULE

Though head shots don't count, if you have 3 or more points touching the ground, a head shot counts as a hit. (ex. Left foot, right foot, and a hand touching the ground while getting hit in the head – defending player is out)



OVERTIME

If time runs out, and there are same amount of active players on the court for both teams, a sudden death round will immediately be in effect.
